

**PARENT/GUARDIAN’S GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP
AGREEMENT/RULES**

As a parent/guardian of a Rosamond Little League player I will up hold to the following sportsmanship agreements.

- I will refrain from use of foul language at all times. Foul language will lead to immediate ejection!
- I will stay off the playing field at all times unless I’m an active coach at the time. If caught going on the field or in the dugout during a game it’s grounds for ejection.
- I will refrain from contact with the players and coaches from outside the field/fence during games. If caught interacting with players or coaches from outside the field/fence during games this is grounds for ejection.
- I will let the coach’s coach and the players play, coaches have reasons for removing players from the game and moving them around to different positions. If you have a question wait until after the game and no players are around and calmly talk with the Manager.
- Do not for any reason cheer for the misfortune of the other team or any other player. This is also grounds for possible ejection.
- Do applaud the effort and play of each and every player on the field.
- I will respect the calls of the Umpires and will not argue with them, this shows the children lack of respect for authority and that it is ok to question the calls of the Umpire staff. Excessive disrespect and warnings may lead to ejection.
- I will never get down on a kid for making an error or loosing a game.
